From Northern Virginia / Washington D.C. Area (and Fredericksburg)

Take Interstate 95 (I-95) South to Fredericksburg
Exit I-95 onto Route 3 East.
The farm is approximately 35 miles East of Fredericksburg.
Continue on Route 3 and through the Intersection with Route 301. See detailed instructions from Rt.3 & 301 below.

From the Southern Maryland Area

Follow Route 301 South into Virginia and continue on Route 301 South for about 12 miles. There is a stop light at the intersection at Rt. 3. Turn left at the light onto Route 3 East. See detailed instructions from Rt.3 & 301 below.

From the Richmond Area:

Take I-95 North, to Exit 104 and follow Route 207 East to Route 301 North.
Continue on Route 301 North through the town of Port Royal to the intersection of Route 301 and Route 3. Turn right at the intersection onto Route 3. See detailed instructions from Rt.3 & 301 below.

Detailed Instructions - Rt. 3 & 301*

Continue on Route 3 for approximately 7.5 miles. You will enter Westmoreland County.
Turn right onto Claymont Road (Rt. 634)
Follow Claymont Road (Rt. 634) for approximately 1 mile.
Turn Right on to Rappahannock Road (Rt. 637).
Follow Rappahannock Road (Rt. 637) for approximately 2.5 miles.
Look for a Berry Farm sign on the right next to Berry Farm Lane.
Turn right on to Berry Farm Lane; keep it slow, you're in the country now!
Follow the road back to the Country Store on the Left where there is parking.

From the Montross, Warsaw, Tappahannock Area

Follow Route 3 West to Oak Grove.
At Oak Grove, continue on Rt.3 West for 1 mile after the stop-light and turn left onto Claymont Road (Rt. 634).
Follow Claymont Road (Rt. 634) for approximately 1 mile.
Turn Right on to Rappahannock Road (Rt. 637).
Follow Rappahannock Road (Rt. 637) for approximately 2.5 miles.
Look for a Berry Farm sign on the right next to Berry Farm Lane.
Turn right on to Berry Farm Lane; keep it slow, you're in the country now!
Follow the road back to the Country Store on the Left where there is parking.
